
#### Key Principles

- Robust governance that provides enterpriselevel focus, measurement and accountability of commodity-centric strategic sourcing
- Leverage and development of enterprise-wide commodity expertise
- From **item-based to commodity** (class of items)-based sourcing strategies
- Commodity expertise, augmented by process expertise, is the key ingredient for strategic sourcing
- Holistic view of the market & supplier base
- Persistent structure which allows for ongoing:
  - Market intelligence
  - Development and maintenance of commodityspecific sourcing strategies
  - Supplier relationship management and development for both competitive and sole source procurement










Supply chain approach aligned to overall product needs




