### GHSC-RTK AND GHSC-PSM MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

- In July 2016, both prime contractors of the GHSC-RTK and GHSC-PSM projects signed an MOU
- Purpose: To identify roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to ensuring the availability of approved HIV rapid test kits (RTKs)
- Important to ensure that host country programs continued to operate without any gap in the supply chain
- Established responsibilities in regards to:
  - HIV RTK supply plans
  - Submission of client requests
  - Receipt and processing of client RTK orders
  - Assistance in services in regards to shipping and delivery
  - Establish actions in regards to QA issues
  - Properly manage emergency orders

### **HIV RTK VENDORS**

- GHSC-RTK is working to establish Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracts with all of our main suppliers
  - We have signed several IDIQs but are in the process of finalizing a few more critical contracts
- Purpose: To lock in pricing for indefinite quantity of delivery of RTKs and associated RTK accessories
  - Benefit: Clients can establish a budget for the procurement and delivery of HIV RTKs
  - Benefit: Help establish supply plans per RTK brand and the budget needed for each screening/confirmatory/tie breaker testing algorithm needs



### HIV RTK VENDORS (CONTINUED)

- Certain IDIQs have tiered pricing which ensures cost savings for larger orders
- Countries order off of country approved algorithms;
   therefore all orders are tendered based off of single/sole source justifications
- As we establish IDIQs with all of our HIV RTK vendors, we are in a position to process orders quickly to meet our client's requests



### **GHSC-RTK VENDOR METRICS**

- GHSC-RTK usually places purchase orders on an EXW basis and measures performance from order placement to pick up
  - Coordinates with RTK vendors to establish reliable and accurate lead times for production
  - Ensure that our client receives product with acceptable shelf life
  - Measure responsiveness of RTK vendor per transaction (purchase order)



### GHSC-RTK VENDOR METRICS (CONTINUED)

GHSC-RTK manages vendor scorecards by measuring the following:

- % of order on time: % of commodity (PO value) provided by the vendor by the promised Inco date
- % of order inaccuracies: % of commodity (PO Value) missing from the completed order
- % of shelf life available: % of commodity shelf life when goods are available for pickup (for import waiver countries the pass tolerance may have to be at least 90%)
- Responsiveness to RMI (subjective): % of time the vendor is adequately responsive

#### THE CHALLENGE

- Poor data visibility because items and products are identified in nonstandard ways
  - Proprietary identification numbers that are reassigned at various points in the supply chain
  - Identification inconsistent across procurement agencies and supply chain stakeholders through to the end user
- Lack of standardization in processes and operations because of inconsistent packaging labels
  - Multiple barcodes
  - Different types of barcodes
  - No barcodes


