To enable identification of every item procured at every point in the supply chain, through administration to the patient


Goal


GLN: Global Location Number

GSI Global Data Synchronisation NetworkTM (GDSN®)



Manufacturers are able to provide data to all kind of databases and all kinds of customers (hospitals, distributors, wholesalers, GPOs) simultaneously, with a single connection.

Our Phase I requirement deadline passed on 30Dec18


What should have been completed to be compliant?

- ✓ Submitted GLNs for all in-scope legal entities and locations
- ✓ Submitted GTINs for all in-scope trade item hierarchies
- ✓ Submitted a sample of your compliant tertiary pack barcode

GHSC-PSM is monitoring compliance against all in-scope trade items under contract and will report feedback through GHSC-PSM supplier scorecards beginning in Q3 FY19.

Phase I by the numbers



In Phase 2, product master data must be synchronized via GDSN by 30Dec19



Compliance will be tracked and reported as a key performance metric in supplier scorecards. Failure to comply will negatively impact a supplier's scorecard starting on 31Dec19.



Proof of compliance will be requested in sourcing events. Failure to comply will be considered in future awards and order allocation decisions.

- Existing suppliers: If an existing supplier responds to a RFx event after 30Dec19 and is not in compliance with the GDSN requirement for existing contracts that the supplier holds with GHSC-PSM, a new supply contract may not be awarded.
- **New suppliers:** A supply contract may not be awarded by GHSC-PSM until such time that a supplier demonstrates that it has established a contract with a GDSN Certified Data Pool.

What do you need to do to get started?

- 1. Subscribe to a GDSN-certified data pool provider of your choice

2. Internal Preparation

- Work with existing or establish an internal master data management process
- Get executive buy-in and create internal initiatives to allow you to invest time and resources in GDSN

RECOMMENDED COMPLETION

By March - June 2019

Publish content to GHSC-PSM via GDSN

- 3. Load the GTIN, GLN, and associated item data into your GDSN data pool solution
 - Reference the GHSC-PSM Data Synchronization Attribute Guide for a complete list of attribute requirements
- 4. Email <u>datasync@ghsc-psm.org</u> indicating you are ready to synchronize your data. GHSC-PSM will subscribe to your GLN in the GDSN.
- 5. Publish items to GHSC-PSM production GLN 0858939007009
 - Reference the <u>GHSC-PSM Data Synchronization Implementation Guide</u> for more detailed specifications related to publication
- 6. Continue to maintain items through the data synchronization process




Synchronizing Your Product Information

I) Is there a match?



- 1) Secure connection established between supplier and recipient
- 2) Product content is shared (synchronized) and updated in real time

Synchronizing Your Product Information



CONFIRM DATA RECEIVED


Manufacturer / Wholesaler Steps

- I) Loading of company product information, you must enter your product content into a data pool. This will require that you pass basic product content validations.
- 2) Registering of company product information, this registers your product at the Global Registry
- 4) Publish product content to GHSC-PSM GLN 0858939007009

GHSC-PSM Steps

- 3) Subscription to source data pool; GHSC-PSM will enter your GLN to be subscribed to in the data pool which will allow for your published information to be received.
- 5) GHSC-PSM will notify you that your content has been received by sending a message through GDSN

2. Product Content Entry and Publication

Once you register with a data-pool service provider, you will have access to a platform where you can enter the specific GHSC-PSM attributes as data entry fields.

This information is securely stored on the data-pool and the information provider chooses who to send (publish) the entered information to

How can we identify your product?

- General Item Information
- Product Description Information
- Unit Indicators

How can we identify the vendor?

- Contact / Role Information
- Additional Trade Item Identification

How does your product work?

- Warranty Information
- Pharmaceutical Information

How is your product Delivered?

- Hierarchy
- Dimensions
- Packaging Information

What do I need to know to distribute your product locally?

- Classifications

- Market Authorization

Global Location Number (GLN)

Attribute Name	Attribute Definition
manufacturerGLN	The Global Location Number used to identify the organization that manufactures this trade item.
brandOwnerGLN	The Global Location Number used to identify the organization that owns the brand
informationProviderGLN	Populate this field with the GLN of the entity responsible for the validity of the item information entered.

- Global Location Number (GLN) represents business entities within the business process
 - Vendors could have the same GLN for informationProviderGLN, brandOwnerGLN manufacturerGLN.
 - Wholesaler Example could have all different GLNs with wholesaler being the Information Provider and GTINs having different Brand Owner & Manufacturer GLNs


Additional Information: Code List & Target Market Use

Code List Standards

- Some Attributes will require entry of specific codes (dataCarrierTypeCode)
- Codes help standardized content coming into GHSC-PSM (GSI_DATA_MATRIX)
 - All data-pools should provide you with a list of valid GDSN codes to communicate specific attributes.
 - Consult the GHSC-PSM Attribute Guide for Specifics

Target Market: D_A

- This is the code to be used when sending product information to GHSC-PSM
- Global Location Number (GLN) of information provider, GTIN of the trade item, and the Target
 Market identifies a unique set of values for the trade items' attributes
 - If any one of the three (GLN, GTIN, Target Market) change you have a new GDSN entry
